**If You Drove a Truck for C.R. England,
Inc. (“C.R. England”) as a Lease-
Operator and Signed a Vehicle Lease
Agreement with Opportunity Leasing, Inc.
(a/k/a Horizon Truck Sales and Leasing)
 (“Horizon”) on or after May 27, 2007 and
on or before January 31, 2017, You Are a
Class Member in a Class Action Lawsuit
Against C.R. England and Horizon.**

Roberts v. C.R. England, et al. is a class
action lawsuit (“Lawsuit”) filed against C.R.
England and Horizon (“Defendants”) in the
United States District Court for the District
of Utah. The Lawsuit involves claims,
among others, that Defendants engaged
in a fraudulent scheme to entice drivers to
sign up for Defendants’ independent lease
operator program; engaged in unfair business
practices and untruthful advertising; and sold
a “business opportunity” without making
the required registrations and disclosures.
The Lawsuit seeks money for damages Class
Members allegedly suffered as a result.
Defendants deny the claims and that they are
liable for any damages. No decision has been
made about whether Plaintiffs or Defendants
are right. Plaintiffs will have to prove these
claims at a trial.

AS A CLASS MEMBER, YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS ARE AFFECTED; ACCORDINGLY, YOU MAY:

DO NOTHING: Stay in the Lawsuit, await the outcome, and give up any right to sue Defendants separately for these claims. If you wish to remain in the Lawsuit, you do not need to do anything. You may get money or benefits from a trial or settlement. But you will be bound by the Court's decision and give up any right to sue Defendants separately for the same claims in the Lawsuit.

ASK TO BE EXCLUDED: Get out of the Lawsuit, get no benefits from it, and keep the right to sue Defendants separately for these claims. If you do not wish to remain in the Lawsuit, you can ask to be excluded. You will not share in any money or benefits that might be awarded in the Lawsuit. But you will keep any rights to sue Defendants separately for the same claims at issue in this Lawsuit.

Who's Included in the Class? The Court certified the Lawsuit as a class action. The Class includes former and current drivers who signed the Independent Contractor Operating Agreement with C.R. England and the Vehicle Leasing Agreement with Horizon during the applicable statute of limitations period, which could extend from May 27, 2007 to January 31, 2017, and drove at least one day for C.R. England.

Who Represents the Class? Class Counsel are the law firms of Robert S. Boulter, San Rafael, CA; Kravit, Hovel & Krawczyk s.c., Milwaukee, WI; Anderson & Karrenberg, Salt Lake City, UT; Harper Law, PLC, Salt Lake City, UT; and Wilentz, Goldman & Spitzer, P.A., Woodbridge, NJ. These attorneys will represent you as part of the Class unless you choose to hire your own attorney who can appear on your behalf, at your own expense. Class Counsel represent the Class on a contingency basis and will receive attorneys' fees and reimbursement of their expenses only if there is a recovery for the Class and the Court awards fees and costs, which may be paid from the Class' recovery.

How to Exclude Yourself from the Class: If you DO NOT wish to remain in the Class, you must send a written request to be excluded to C.R. England Lawsuit, EXCLUSIONS, c/o A.B. Data, Ltd., P.O.
